# Financials

---

- Overall Budget available is **€2,000,000**, €1million funded by the European Union under the Digital Europe Programme & €1million sourced from National funds
- Aid intensity set at 80%, whereby the maximum permissible grant is set at **€60,000**
- Projects considered are to have a **total project value of €20,000 and over**
- **Disbursement of Funds** will take place in two phases:
  - Pre-financing aid of 20% upon Grant Agreement Signature
  - The remaining 80% will be reimbursed upon Completion of Project

# Timeframes

---

- Scheme managed through **Open Rolling Calls**
  - First come first served
  - 4 Cut-off dates as follows:

JULY 20, 2023

SEPTEMBER 14, 2023

NOVEMBER 9, 2023

DECEMBER 29, 2023

- Scheme will close on **29 December 2023**
- Projects must be implemented by not later than **30 September 2024**

# Evaluation

---

- **Project Selection Committee** will evaluate the projects
- Assessment will be made based on a set of pre-defined **gateway criteria (100%)** and **selection criteria (50%)**
  - Gateway Criteria:
    1. Complete application form;
    2. Eligible undertaking;
    3. Eligible action and activities;
    4. Match financing;
  - Selection Criteria:
    1. Project excellence (45 marks);
    2. Impact and sustainability (30 marks);
    3. Project risk assessment (25 marks);
- MITA, through the National Cybersecurity Coordination Centre (NCC-MT), will be in contact on the outcome



# Implementation

---

- If successful, a **Grant Agreement** between MITA and the Beneficiary will be signed, whereby the management of project will be done through a dedicated [NCC Funding Management Portal](#)
- Projects are subject to **spot checks** and **audits**
