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#### **EU Nationals**

### Under 3 months

 Exercising Treaty rights – Freedom of Movement

### Over 3 months

- Proof of scope to reside
- May work without a residence document

## **Third-Country Nationals**

# Third-country nationals require residence **permit** to reside and work in Malta

• TCNs: foreign nationals who are <u>not</u> EU Nationals or nationals of Liechtenstein, Norway, Switzerland and Iceland

eResidence document specifies the scope of residence

- Change of scope requires new application and approval
- Validity is also dependent on validity of scope
- Immigration status lost upon loss /change of scope

Employment and Residence in Malta (only)

Remains dependent on Labour Market exigencies


Tied to specific employer and designation

Employer is to ensure that the company is registered with Jobsplus

# **Using the Online Portal**


- Requires e-ID access

# Third-country nationals holding a permit issued by another EU member state


Holders of the below in another EU member state are not eligible for Employment in Malta:

- Refugee Status
- Humanitarian protection
- Subsidiary protection



#### The Approval in Principle

- Not a substitute for a residence permit
- Fixed period of validity
- Information provided on it:
  - Biometrics appointment booking link and process
  - Terms & conditions
  - Type of application submitted (in the footer)
  - Unique verification code
  - List of documents to be submitted during the biometrics appointment
  - Visa application details



Should you require a visa to enter the Schengen area of Europe, you are required to present a letter with your visa application form, and other required supporting documents, to the pertinent Maltese Embassy or Maltese Consulate within 180 days of receipt of this letter.

Where there is no Maltese Embassy or Consul present in an applicant's country of residence, your employer is to contact the Central Visa Unit at Identity Malta Agency on visa.ima@gov.mt, so as to obtain the necessary authorisation to apply for a visa at the nearest operational Maltese Embassy

Kindly note that the issuing of a Schengen visa is without prejudice to any decision by border control authorities to refuse entry into the Schengen territory for failing to fulfil all the conditions of entry or where the intention of travelling to Malta is not for the purpose of the authorisation that has been

Obtaining your work and residence permit (single permit).

Kindly access https://booksinglepermit.identitymalta.com to fix a one-time appointment with Identity Malta Agency in order to have your biometric data and photo taken. This procedure must be carried out within 90 days and failure to do so would nullify the contents of this letter

Should you need to cancel this appointment, you may do so up to three (3) days before the appointment date. Failure to attend an appointment without explanation may result in the

This appointment should be set within the period of your authorized stay in Malta, which is six months from the date of this letter. This letter shall serve as confirmation of such authorisation of stay, whereby the six-month period also includes any other stay authorised by means of the period

For your appointment at the Identity Malta Agency, please bring the following documents:

- Local/European full refund insurance policy showing coverage for medical assistance including hospital treatment, during the first period of stay in Malta
- . Lease of property agreement that clearly refers to you and shows termination date
- Copy of Approval Letter given to Landlord by the Housing Authority upon registering of
- . Health Screening evidence as stipulated on Identity Malta's website

If you will be working within the catering industry or security sector, these additional documents

Kindly note that a work/residence permit authorises you to reside in Malta provided that you are engaged in employment as specified in your permit.

Validity period establishes migration status



# Responsibilities linked to the Single Permit

- The Employer must inform Identity Malta, if:
  - a TCN does not turn up for employment,
  - a TCN who has been employed is terminated, contract not renewed or resigns
  - loses track of a still abroad applicant
- National Employment Regulations apply at all times this includes the engagement and termination processes
- Significant Change in Designation mandates new application
- Change in address must be registered with the Agency

## **Revocation of Residence Permit**

#### Reasons for revocation, may include:

- Employment delineated on residence document is terminated
- Sponsor of residence permit holder no longer holds a valid and legal immigration status in Malta
- Non-attendance of the educational course upon which permit was issued
- Permit holder absconded from Malta
- Abuse and Fraud
